



Changes to Chichester District Mobile Recycling Sites

from 1st October 2016



Increased demand for essential services, coupled with reduced government funding, means we need to reduce our spending in other areas. Changes at West Sussex Household Waste Recycling Sites (HWRSSs) and Mobile Recycling Sites will help us make critical savings while still maintaining a comprehensive service for residents.

The changes were decided after considering responses to the public consultation from residents and comments from

As well as a number of changes taking place at permanent HWRs across the County, the decision has been made to close the following Chichester District mobile recycling services.

Fernhurst	Petworth
Hambrook	South Harting
Kirdford	Wisborough Green

Selsey and The Witterings will remain open on a fortnightly basis. Please see opposite for details.

When will the changes take place?

All closures will take place by 1st October 2016. Below is a table which shows the last operating dates for each of the mobile recycling services in Chichester District.

What changes are taking place at Selsey and The Witterings?

Selsey and The Witterings mobile recycling services will now open on a Thursday on a fortnightly basis rather than weekly.

From 1st October 2016 The Witterings service will accept green waste, wood and small electrical items.

Metal, mixed card and paper will also be accepted. All of these items need to be loose when placed in the containers. Please check the calendar below for more information on operating days and times.

How do I report fly-tipping?

If you see someone fly-tipping or would like to report an area where fly-tipping has taken place, you should make a note of the following.

- The date, time and place of the occurrence
- What the waste looks like and how much there is
- A description of any vehicles involved, including the vehicles registration numbers
- A description of any persons involved in the offence
